Trash Cans

Trash cans are to be stored in your backyard or garage where they are out of view from the street. You may take your trash can out the night before pick up and you must bring it in the day of pick up.



Wiring

There should not be any exposed or exterior wiring on your property. All wiring should be run on the interior or between walls, not on the outside of the house.



Landscaping

Please ensure that your have proper ground cover that you can manager and is conducive to our climate and watering conditions. Grass can grow with once a week watering. You can also hand water as necessary. If you do not want to put this effort into your yard, look at alternative options, some can be found at SAWS.org. When you find the plan that works for you, make sure you have Association ACC approval before moving forward. Your yard should be done at least twice a month. Please do not blow grass clippings into the street, water your yard appropriately, treat for weeds and do not allow grass or weeds to grow between the cement of your driveway/sidewalk or in the street. All planters must have plants and no weeds.



Single Family Residence

Huntington Place is a single family community. Please follow these rules. If you have a rental property please ensure your renters follow the single family ordinance.



Wind Storm & Hail

The recent wind storm and hail has caused some shingles to come off. Please make sure you deal with these issues appropriately. You cannot patch your roof and have an appearance that is not uniform. If you have collected insurance monies for your roof, all funds need to be used for the replacement of the roof.
